




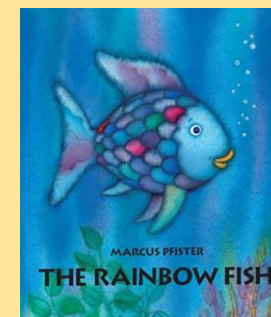


English
