Irresistible Learning: (River Deep, Mountain High)

Activity 1: Key features of a mountain range
Here are some of the key features of mountains:
Foot - the bottom of the mountain
Summit - the top of a mountain
Plateau - an area of flat, high ground
Ridge - a long, narrow, high section of land
Snow line - above this line snow and ice cover the mountain all year
Face - the 'side' of a mountain
Tree line - the highest point forests are found
Slope - an area of ground increasing in height
Activity: Using the word bank above, can you draw a picture of a mountain range and label the key features?
