<p>Topic (Art - History - Geography)</p> <p>Task 1 Watch the video of Tim Peake going into space. <i>Where do you think they are going? Why would you want to go into space? How do you think they are feeling when the rocket is launching?</i> See what you can find out about Tim Peake and make a poster about him. 	<p>Computing</p> <p>Use JITS to practise coding the big bad wolf to move around the screen. Can you blow down each house?</p> <p>Science – Materials- Recycling Watch this video to understand the importance of recycling and getting rid of waste correctly. Make a poster outlining the importance of recycling and showing which materials can be recycled.</p> 	<p>Reading - <i>We would like you to read or listen to a story for at least 20 minutes a day.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Audible - click here- Authorfy - here- Storyline – choose a story from here <p>Pick a book/magazine/comic and take it in turns to read a page with someone else. Give each other a voice to read the page in e.g. like a robot, a mouse, a giant, a shy person, an excited person etc.</p>	<p>PE Before their mission astronauts undergo training to make sure they can perform tasks such as a 'walk-back'. It is important they have good endurance.</p> <p>Try some interval training - walk then run 4 times. This could be the length of your garden, the distance between 2 trees at the park or between 2 lampposts on your road. You could do 30sec walk on the spot, 30sec run on the spot, 4 times. What happens to your heart rate during the activity? What happens to your breathing?</p>
