Number, shape & measures:
Number of the week: 8
 Watch [this episode](#) of Numberblocks to learn more about the number 8. Can you count out 8 objects? Is the number 8 odd or even?



Shape of the week: Cone
 A cone is a 3D shape. It has 2 faces. Would it be a good 3D shape to build a tower? Can you think of anything that is shaped like a cone?



Activity: Challenge to see how far you can jump! Have a starting line to jump from. Once the children have jumped, ask them to stand still or put a marker down. Measure how far they've jumped in heel-to-toe footsteps or hand spans. Is your next jump further?

 Encourage your child to write these words by using their segmenting fingers to identify how many sounds are in the word. This will then help them to write the sounds they need to build the word.





The World/topic **Irresistible Learning Topic:** Penguins
