


Home-learning

Storms and Shipwrecks



Art: In school we will be creating some beautiful sunset silhouette pictures. Use what you have at home to create one of your own. Here are some examples:



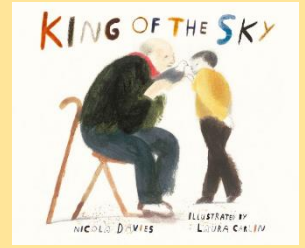
English
