Maths

Oak Academy: This week we are continuing with multiplication and division. [Start on lesson eleven and complete a new lesson every day.](#) [Lesson 1](#), [lesson 2](#) and [lesson 3](#) from White Rose on multiplication and division of 2-digit by 1-digit numbers, could also be used alongside Oak Academy. The worksheets are set as a 2Do on Purple Mash.



Challenge: The highest and lowest challenge. Use + or – or x or ÷ between any of the 3 of the numbers opposite. What is the highest possible number and what is the lowest possible number?

How many different answers can you make?

Fluency:
