

Number, shape & measures:

Number of the week: 10. Watch this episode of [numberblocks](#). Can you recall the numbers that made 10? You could use a tower of 10 blocks to help you recall how 10 can be split up.



Shapes of the week: sphere. A sphere is a 3D shape with one curved face and no vertices. Can you find spheres in your home? Can you find a sphere that you can throw and catch?

Challenge: Watch this episode of the [numberblocks](#) and think about how the characters get the bridges to balance. If I put 10 on one side of the bridge, what two numbers could go on the other side to make the bridge balance? Can you think of more than one way to do it?




The World/topic Irresistible Learning Topic: Journeys

Lesson 3 Play [Picnic on Pluto](#) on Phonics play. Click on phase 3 and 'revise all phase 3' to play.

Reading: Read some of your books on [Bug Club](#).

Before you read your book can you predict what might happen?


Retell the story in your own words. Was it a fiction or non-fiction book?
