Number, shape & measures:
 Go over the numbers 1-5. Can you recognise each number, can you put them in order? Can you have a go writing each number? You could try adding two of the numbers together. What is 1 more, what is 1 less than 3?

Shape of the Week: triangle  How many sides does it have? Can you tell your adult about what it looks like? Have a go at drawing some different size triangles.


Activity 2: See if you can decorate a sandcastle. Get your adult to draw an outline for you. What things will you put on yours? How will you decorate it?

Phonics: This week we are learning the sound 'd'. Listen to this song [Jolly Phonic song d](#) see if you can do the action and say the sound. Writing/Mark Making: Draw a summer picture. What things are you going to draw? Write your name on your drawing. Remember to start your name with a capital letter and write the rest in lower case.
