Task 2: Watch this [video](#) to find out about Queen Elizabeth I – write down 3 facts you have learnt.

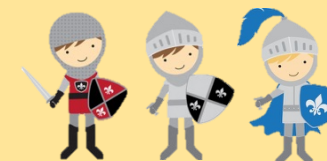
Challenge: Can you draw a picture of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Elizabeth II.



English – Three Little Knights

This week we are continuing to look at the story The Three Little Knights which is a play on the story The Three Little Pigs.

Instead of three little pigs there are three little knights and instead of a big bad wolf there is a big bad dragon, this is in keeping with our topic turrets and tiaras.



Task 1: Recap the story of The Three Little Knights, write the beginning of the story (until they find the materials for their house).

Task 2: Write the problem of the story (until the dragon blew down the 1st Little Knights house).

Task 3: Write the resolution of the story (until the dragon blew down the 2nd Little Knights house).

Task 4: Write the ending of the story (until the end of the story).

Phonics:

For the next few weeks we will be focusing on consolidating and practising the letter sounds learnt so far and reading and spelling words which have adjacent consonants.
