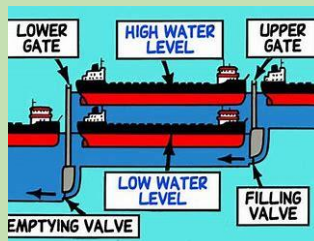

Create your own canal –

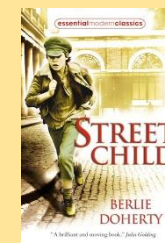
