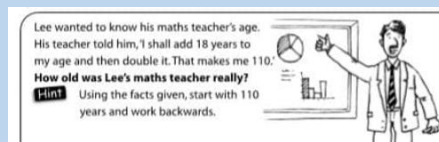

Irresistible Learning Topic – Ice Worlds

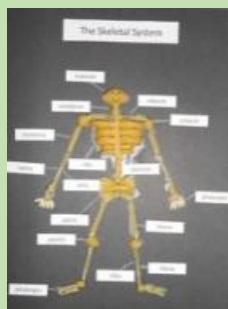
History:
