Your task is to create a picture of a Roman soldier and label all of the weapons and clothing/armour they would have had. You may also want to think about what made the army so successful.


Use [this website](#) to find out more facts to help with your pictures and support you with spelling. You can use other websites to help you but remember what we have learnt about internet safety if you do.
