Thank you all so much for supporting us as a school through this incredibly challenging week. All our staff have been working so hard every day, in order to put in all the necessary changes in place.

During the last national lockdown in March 2020 we were initially open for five critical worker 'bubbles'. On Monday January 11th 2021 we will be open for 16 'bubbles' of vulnerable pupils and critical worker's children. The school is once again split into 3 zoned areas. This will have a direct impact on the number of staff required in school daily to support school opening.
