### Number, shape & measures:

**Position:** See if you can create a large farm map, with pictures and farm animal models. Your child could then drive a car/tractor/toy animal around a route. What do they see on the way? Encourage the children to use positional language such as next to, between, in front of and behind.

### Communication, language & literacy

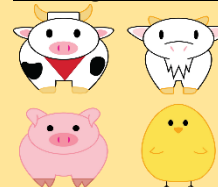
**Reading** This week we are sharing the book **The Noisy, Noisy Farm**. Listen to the story together [The Noisy, Noisy Farm](#)
