Number, shape & measures:

Counting: Draw a black circle and get your child to draw/stick on 8 legs. See if they can count the right amount of legs independently.



Can you count to 8? Can you show your adult 8 fingers, count 8 claps and 8 jumps?

Word of the Week: rhyme

Reading Listen to this Nursery Rhyme [Incy Wincy Spider](#) Can you sing along to it? Do you know any of the actions for it? Can you hear which words rhyme? [spout/out and rain/again]



Phonics: Rhyming- 'spout' and 'out' rhyme. Can you think of anymore words that rhyme with them? [about, shout, scout] What words can you think of that rhyme with rain? [drain, pain, train]

Writing/Mark Making: See if you can draw a spider with 8 legs. You



could even try drawing a web for it.

Wellbeing – What makes a good friend?

This week we are continuing to think about kindness and friendship. It is important for us to have good friends around us to talk to and play with. What makes a good friend? How can we make sure we are being a good friend? See if you can draw one of your friends and say why they are your friend.
