
Task 1: Write your royal rules. If you were the monarch what would your rules be? Come up with 3 rules that you would have.

English – Three Little Knights

This week we are looking at the story The Three Little Knights which is a play on the story The Three Little Pigs. Instead of three little pigs there are three little knights and instead of a big bad wolf there is a big bad dragon, this is in keeping with our topic turrets and tiaras.



Task 1: Think of 5 adjectives to describe the Three Little Knights (pictures above).

Task 2: Put the adjectives you came up with yesterday for the knights into a sentence? E.g. The knight has a blue shield.

Task 3: Make puppets of the Three Little Knights, you can use paper or any other materials that you have available to you.

Task 4: Using the puppets you made yesterday act out the story of The Three Little Knights.

Phonics:

Reading:

Pick a story book from home or one from Bug Club. Who are the characters in the book? Can you predict what happened in the story? Once you've read the story were you right, did you predict correctly?
