Oak Academy: Time – complete one lesson each day.

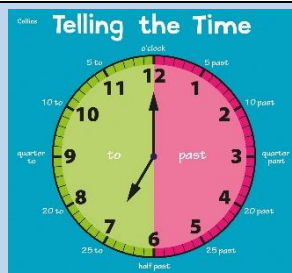

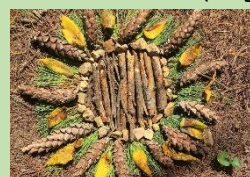


Mental fluency:	Challenge:

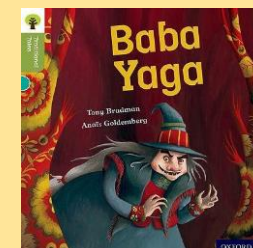
