<p>Maths – Addition and Subtraction</p> <p>This week we are looking at addition and subtraction. Look below for the lessons for this week. Use our example to help: 'I have big knees. I like swinging in the trees.' You might want to do this for more than one animal. Lesson 5 – Can you create a new book cover for 'Rumble in the Jungle'. Think about what you would like to see on the front of the book that would make you want to read it.</p> <p>Phonics: Recap the Phase 3 sounds we have learnt by looking at the flashcards on PurpleMash. This term we are looking at Phase 5 and we are learning four new sounds. Click on the links to learn our new sounds: ay, ou, ea and oy.</p> <p>Our tricky words are: said says do like little Can you put these words into a sentence?</p>
<p>Irresistible Learning – Continents</p> <p>This week, we are learning all about the continents that make up the world.</p> <p>Do you know how many there are? Before reading the book have a think: is the book fiction or non-fiction? Can you predict what you think is going to happen in the book?
