Shape of the Week: circle 
 What things can you find that are a circle shape at home? Have a go at drawing round something that is circle shaped.


Irresistible Learning Topic: Knock, Knock, Who's There- Rhymes


Colour- Blue Our new topic for this term is all about traditional stories. We will be reading a different story each week.

Word of the Week: rhyme
Reading We are talking about our favourite stories and rhymes this week. Do you have a favourite story and/or rhyme? Why do you like it?
Phonics: Rhythm and Rhyme Can you think of any words that rhyme with bun? [fun, run, sun, done] Can you think of any words that rhyme with shop? [top, stop, mop, pop]. Can you hear these rhyming words in the rhyme [Five Currant Buns](#)? Are there anymore rhyming words?

Writing/Mark Making: Draw 5 currant buns or draw your favourite character from a book.
