



Year Group: Reception	WEEK BEGINNING: 21/3/2022

Number, shape & measures:

 Can you count out 10 different objects or do 10 big jumps.




Shape of the week: Rectangle and Cuboid.
 A cuboid is 3D. A rectangle is 2D. What other facts can you remember about these shapes?




Activity: Place 10 cushions or pieces of paper into 5 rows of 2 to resemble seats on a bus. Use teddies and toys and place 4 so they are sitting on the bus. Ask 'how many more could fit on the bus'. Encourage them to say, '4 and 6 makes 10'. Repeat with a different number of toys on the bus.
