Complete a new lesson every day. Writing Challenge: We are looking at some different fairy tales. Think about your favourite traditional stories and then see if you can rewrite one using your own words. You could complete the 2Do using Purple Mash to retell the story of The Three Little Pigs. Phonics/ SPaG: Play this game Against the clock using our year 3 words. Reading: Have some fun logging on to Bug Club and see what books you have been given to read.</p> <p>Set yourself a reading challenge for the year ahead. Is there a new author you would like to read or a topic you would like to read about? Write down your challenge and then let us know when you complete it.</p>
