### English

**Oak Academy: Persuasion: Why you should never light fires in a dry forest** - complete a new lesson each day (**lessons 6-10**).

**Extra writing challenge:** listen to the story 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane' by Katie Haworth ([click here](#)). What famous landmarks does Emma see on her journey? Choose one of the landmarks and write a short description, using interesting noun phrases.



**Kinetic Letters (handwriting):** Now we have gone through all the letter families, practise the following letter pairs from [The Fisher family](#): gj, gy, gf, jy, jf, jg, fj, fg and fy.

**Phonics/SPaG:** This week we are looking at adding -ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y to a root word ending in -e with a consonant before it (e.g. hike changes to hiked, hiking or hiker). On Purple Mash, there is a spelling quiz and a spelling sheet for you to have a go at, both set as **2Dos**.

**Reading:**
