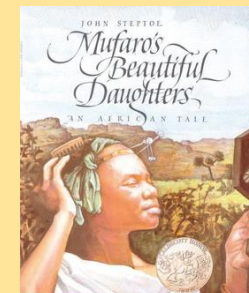
English
