This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 3 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for home-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

<p><b>Maths</b> <b>Oak Academy</b> – this week we’ll be starting a new unit on place value. Complete a lesson each day (lessons 1 -5) by clicking <a href="#">here</a></p> <p>Lesson 1– reading and writing 3-digit numbers Lesson 2 – partitioning numbers in different ways Lesson 3 – ordering and comparing 3-digit numbers Lesson 4 – adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers Lesson 5 – rounding 2 and 3-digit numbers to the nearest 10</p> <p><b>Mental fluency</b> Play the <a href="#">Toy Shop Game</a> to practise your money skills. Choose mixed coins and then £1 to £10.</p>	<p><b>English</b> <b>Oak Academy</b> – this week we continue our unit on Portia spiders – non-chronological reports. Click <a href="#">here</a> and choose a new lesson each day (lessons 11-15)</p> <p><b>Extra writing challenge:</b> What is your favourite book or story? Can you retell the story in your own words? You could write your own story using your favourite book character: where will they visit and what will happen to them? For example Paddington could visit Willy Wonka’s chocolate factory. You could combine two of your favourite stories and characters and write what happens. If you like comics, you could create your own comic character and tell a story using a comic strip. Have fun using ideas from your favourite books and see what you can create.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Log onto <a href="#">Bug Club</a> to see what books your teacher has given you to read. Perhaps you could create a book review of the book you most enjoyed reading.</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b> Log into <b>Purple Mash</b> and you will find your spelling list has been set as a <b>2do</b>. There is also a spelling quiz for you to complete. This week’s spellings all have the -tion ending.</p>
<p><b>Irresistible Learning:</b> <b>History/Art</b> - Dig It topic This week we will be learning about fossils from the Stone Age. Read the information <a href="#">here</a> and watch the animation that shows how fossils are made. Then watch this <a href="#">video</a> to find out how you can make your very own prehistoric fossil!</p> <p><b>Science</b> – Plants</p> <p>In school we are beginning a new unit on plants. Follow this <a href="#">link</a> to discover the conditions needed for plants to grow. Complete the activities discussed in the video. See if you are able to grow some of your own plants at home.
