
**Number, shape & measures:**  
**Number of the week:** 9.  
Listen to [this song](#) about the number 9.  
What facts do you know about number 9? Can you say what one more and one less is? Is the number odd or even?



**Shape of the week:** Pyramid and Triangle  
A pyramid is 3D. A triangle is 2D. What else do you know about these shapes? Watch [this video](#) about a pyramid.

**Activity:** PRIOR TO THE ACTIVITY, HIDE 10 OBJECTS AROUND THE ROOM.  
Mark out a large 10 frame on the carpet (you could use 10 pieces of A4 paper and arrange them like a tens frame). Ask the child to hunt for the objects around the room. Each time they find one they have to place it on the frame. Stop at different points to discuss how many have been found and how many are left to find.

**Reading:** *Read these sentences. Can you spot the digraphs? (Remember 2 letters, 1 sound)*  
*The chair was in the air!*  
*I was as high up as the ladder.*  
*My rabbit needs a bigger carrot.*  
**Writing:**  
Here are some words- **chair, fair, letter, hammer, bigger, rabbit, hidden, kitten**  
Encourage your child to write these words by using their segmenting fingers to identify how many sounds are in the word. This will then help them to write the sounds they need to build the word.
