Phonics Rhyme watch this [video clip](#) about rhyming words. Can you think of any words of your own that rhyme with sun, car or cat?

Writing/Mark Making: Put some rice in a shallow box or tray, just enough to cover the bottom. Make some marks using a chop stick or a pencil. Can you write your name? Can you write any letters? **(The rice can be dyed red with food colouring and a squirt of hand sanitiser, mix thoroughly, spread out on newspaper and leave to dry overnight)**
