




Year Group: 2	WEEK BEGINNING: 25.01.2021

Phonics/ SPaG: Now that we have completed phase 5 we are starting to learn the spelling rules for Year 2. This week we are looking at **homophones and near homophones**. This week, we would also like you to practise some **Year 2 Common Exception Words** using the [Little Bird Spelling](#) game (select Y2 and practise spelling the words: **old, cold, gold, hold, told, mother, father, brother** and **sister** in the third bird box from the left.)
