Try counting some real money. If you have a money bank empty it out, sort the coins into different values and then add up the totals for each set of coins. This also helps us to count in different steps.



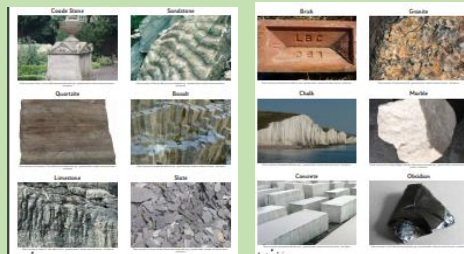
**Fluency:**

Did you like the story of Ug?

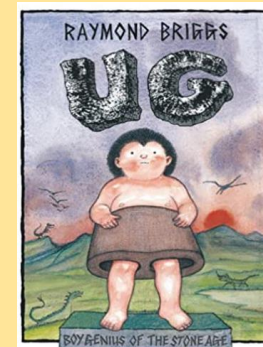
Were his parents good parents?

Why didn't anyone understand Ug?

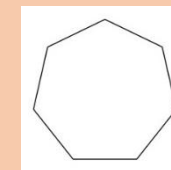
