<p><u>Maths</u> Oak Academy – this week we’ll be starting a new unit on multiplication and division. 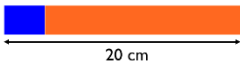
Here is a blue strip of paper.



An orange strip is four times as long.

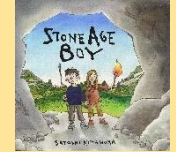


The strips are joined end to end.
