Maths

Spelling: This week we are looking at some common exception words, there is a sheet of spellings and a quiz to complete on Purple Mash.

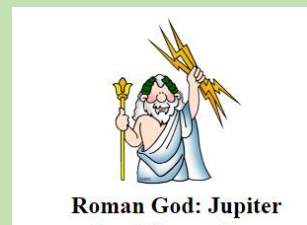


Irresistible Learning:

Italian Adventure-Roman Gods

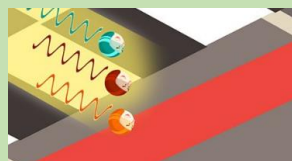
Watch this clip and look at the information about Roman Gods.
