Task: Using the diagram below, can you carefully draw and label an adult set of teeth.


Types of teeth
Humans have three main types of teeth:

- 1. Incisors**
Incisors help you bite off and chew pieces of food.
- 2. Canines**
These teeth are used for tearing and ripping food.
- 3. Molars**
These help you crush and grind food.




Our teeth will change with age. So, the teeth you have when you are a baby aren't the same as the one's you will have as an adult.
