Number, shape & measures:

Lesson 1 : Number of the week: 5 — Can you make your own Numberblock? You could use blocks or draw a picture. Will your number 5 be in a straight line or will it make a shape?

Shape of the week: **cylinder** – Watch this <u>video</u>. Can you find any cylinders in your home?

Lesson 2: Have a teddy bears picnic. Give the teddy bears snacks such as fruit or crackers. Is it fair? Now can you share it out fairly?

Lesson 3: Make yourself some dotty cards with 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 dots on them. Mix them up, can you quickly put them back in order?


Lesson 4: Use your dotty cards from yesterday. Can you make the number in a different way? You could count out a number of toys or crayons to match the card.

Lesson 5: Can you join in with <u>this video</u>? See if you can quickly recognise the number that is represented.

<u>The World/topic</u> <u>Irresistible Learning Topic:</u> Winter Listen to the story <u>'The Gruffalo's Child'</u>.

What animals did the Gruffalo's Child meet along the way? Can you draw pictures of the animals?

<u>Writing:</u> Can you write these words? Can you put them into a sentence e.g. The red mat. What sounds do they begin with?











<u>Kinetic Letters-</u> Practise the letters /h/ and /n/ (Please see Evidence Me for support)

What things make you feel happy? Can you draw a smiley/happy face? What things are you looking forward to doing again when you can?
