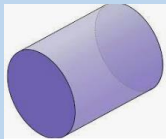
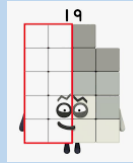

Number, shape & measures:

Number of the week: 19. Watch this episode of [numberblocks](#) to learn about the number 19. Can you count out 19 pieces of pasta or cereal?



Shape of the week: cylinder. Remember we can describe a cylinder as a 3D shape that has 3 faces. It has two flat circular faces and one curved face. Can you find cylinders in your home?

Challenge: This week we are learning about length. Can you find some objects in your house to order by length? See if you can use the vocabulary of longest and shortest in your sentences. Try to measure some of your items using a ruler or tape measure.



The World/topic Irresistible Learning Topic: Mermaids

Activity 1: Listen to the story [The Singing Mermaid](#) by Julia Donaldson. Can you make some puppets of the characters from the story and retell it?



Activity 2: Listen to the song '[Under the sea](#)'. Can you dance along and join in with some of the words to the song?



When you are listening to the song can you draw or paint a picture to go with it? What animals might you include in your Under the Sea picture?

Retell the story in your own words. Was it a fiction or non-fiction book?



Writing: Write a list of animals that live under the sea. Can you write a sentence about one of the animals?
