Scarlett: The whole number that my decimal rounds to is also the digit that can be found in the tenths column. The only digit that rounds down is in the hundredths column. My decimal uses more odd than even numbers.

Atticus: When rounded to the nearest tenth, my decimal has the same digit in the ones and tenths columns. This digit is also a prime number. The digits in the ones and tenths columns are the only digits in my decimal that round down. The thousandths digit is 2.

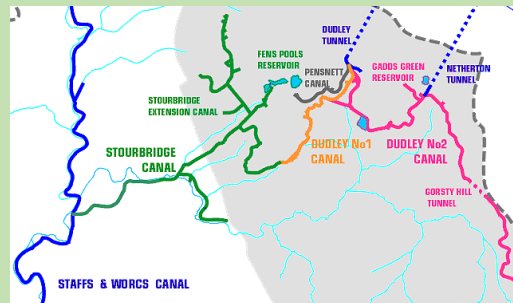
