Task: Research the Great Barrier Reef, find out our impact on it and any interesting facts you can find. Create a poster using the 2Do template.

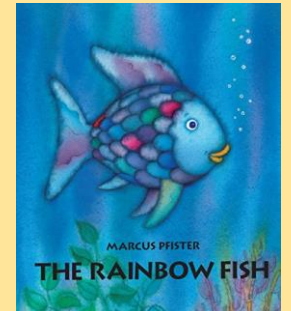
History

Kinetic Letters (handwriting): Recap how to form your capital letters in the **Curved Lines group** ([click here for the video](#)).

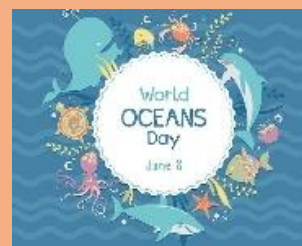
