

Challenge:
 In school we have been telling 'first, then and now' stories related to addition and subtraction. Can you do this at home? For example – first there were five people on the bus, then two more got on, now there are seven people on the bus altogether.

The World/topic
Irresistible Learning Topic: People who help us- Police and Firefighters.



Activity 1: Discuss what you know about the police and firefighters. Then on Espresso search 'How do the police help us' and read the book. Also search for 'What do firefighters do' and watch the video. What have you learnt that you didn't know before?

Activity 2: Using either recycled materials, Lego or other toys you have to make a police car or fire engine. Can you make it move? What noise might it make? Can you draw your own police car or fire engine? You could write some words around the picture to describe them. You might include 'red' and 'fast' for a fire engine.
