






Home-learning

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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 3 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for home-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

<p><u>Maths</u> Oak Academy – this week we will begin a new unit on fractions. Choose a new lesson each day (lessons 1-5) Click here</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Challenge – True or False?</p> <p>The rectangle is split into four equal parts.</p>  <p>Lesson 1 – describe the part whole relationship Lesson 2 – recognise parts that are equal and parts that are unequal Lesson 3 – recognise, identify and describe unit fractions Lesson 4 – find unit fractions of a given quantity Lesson 5 – describe unit and non-unit fractions</p> <p>Mental fluency - Beat the Clock - level 4 Can you answer the questions before the time runs out?</p>	<p><u>English</u> Oak Academy – this week we begin a unit on the book, The Happy Prince. Complete one lesson each day (lessons 1-5). Click here</p> <p>Extra writing challenge: In school we will be studying fairy tales and their features. Fairy tales usually have good and bad characters. Can you design your own good character for a fairy tale and write a description? <i>You could send your work to your class teachers using 2email on Purple Mash.</i></p>  <p>Reading: Have a look at home to see if you have any fairy tales that you could read. If you don't have any, then maybe a family member could look in the local library for you.</p> <p>Spelling: Log into Purple Mash and you will find your spelling list has been set as a 2do. There is also a spelling quiz for you to complete.</p>
