Topic (Art - History - Geography)

American Food:

This week we would like you to develop your cooking skills! First, research traditional American dishes [here](#). Then design a three course (American themed) menu. Try to describe each dish using lots of interesting adjectives. **Tip:** divide an A4 piece of paper into thirds- give the headings: starter, mains and desserts. Draw or describe each dish.

Challenge:

Try to make or taste some American dishes if you can. Think about: how you would improve the dish? How could you make it healthier? What you would rate it out of 10? **Tip:** Try this simple American pancake [recipe](#).

Maths Oak Academy- Week 11-(click here)

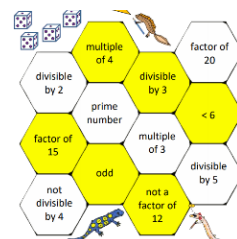
Complete the tasks over this week – **one maths lesson per day** completing the maths quiz, main activity and final quiz.
