Number, shape & measures:
Pudsey Bear Maths: You will need a Pudsey bear picture/dice with dots/stickers to stick on or a felt tip to make dots. Children to roll a dice (or draw some dots on pieces of paper and choose at random) and count the dots. See if you can count out that number of stickers/spots and stick/draw them onto your Pudsey.




Irresistible Learning Topic: Here I am: All About Me: Babies and Birthdays.
Colour of the Week: pink
Understanding of the World:
Birthdays: Can you talk about what happens at birthdays? What sort of activities do you do at birthday parties? What presents did you get?
Watch: [The Cake Bake](#) what did Sarah make for Duck's birthday?
Media & materials:
See if you can make and design your own birthday cake with whatever resources you have at home. You could use coloured paper, tissue paper, stickers, pens and crayons. See if you can stick some candles on the cake. How many will they put on? Can you count them?

Reading: This week we are sharing the story **The Birthday Invitation**. Share the story together [The Birthday Invitation](#) What different characters found the lost invitation? Which of them would you like to come to your party? Have you had an invite to a party before?

Writing/Mark Making: Make your own birthday card. Draw a picture on the front. Could you draw some balloons or a cake perhaps? Who is the card for? Can you trace over the letters in their name inside the card?

This week we will be thinking about: Anti-bullying and Friendships. Talk about who your friends are and why you like them. When we play together, what is kind and unkind?
