Number, shape & measures:
Pattern: Can you make an Autumn repeating pattern using leaves, acorns, pine cones or conkers? Try using 2 of these items for the pattern e.g. leaf-acorn-leaf-acorn or leaf- leaf-conker-conker-leaf-leaf-conker-conker




Size/sorting: See if you can find some leaves and sort them into different sizes: small, medium and big. How else could you sort them?

Colour of the Week: brown

Phonics: General Sound Discrimination See if you can hear the different sounds from around the home in this game [Guess the sound at home](#) What sounds did you hear?

Writing/Mark Making: See if you find some leaves to do some leaf rubbings. Put any leaves you find underneath some paper and then roll a crayon over the top and you should see the shape of the leaf appear on your paper.
