Number, shape & measures:
Counting/addition/subtraction Have a go at drawing a road for any toy cars you have at home or you could get your grown up to draw some. Draw some parking spaces and put some cars in the spaces. How many spaces are there? You could tell stories such as if one car drives off how many will you have now. If 2 more arrive how many cars are parked now? How many spaces are empty if 3 are parked etc.



Irresistible Learning Topic: Moving Along- Transport on the road
Our new topic for this term is Moving Along and we will be finding out about different types of transport and talking about holidays.

Activity 1 What is your favourite transport that travels on the road? It could be a car, bus, lorry, tractor or bike for example. See if you can draw/ paint a picture of it. What do you know about that form of transport? See if you can describe it to your grown up.
