



A cylinder is a 3D shape. It has 3 faces. Can you find anything around your house that is shaped like a cylinder?



Activity: Can you count to 20? Can you count backwards from 20? Choose a number to count to. Can you count forwards to the number and then back from that number?

Reading: *Read these sentences. Can you spot the digraphs? (Remember 2 letters, 1 sound)*
It is fun to stamp and twist to the drums.
My boots went squelch in the mud.
I can scrunch up my hair and put it in a hair band.

Writing:
Here are some words-**stamp, twist, blend, crunch, string, strong, sprint, scrunch**
Encourage your child to write these words by using their segmenting fingers to identify how many sounds are in the word. This will then help them to write the sounds they need to build the word.



The World/topic

Irresistible Learning Topic: People who help us- Police and Firefighters.


Activity 1: Discuss what you know about the police and firefighters. Then on Espresso search 'How do the police help us?' and read the book. Also search for 'What do firefighters do?' and watch the video. What have you learnt that you didn't know before?

Activity 2: Using either recycled materials, Lego or other toys you have make a police car or fire engine. Can you make it move? What noise might it make? Can you draw your own police car or fire engine? You could write some words around the picture to describe them. You might include 'red' and 'fast' for a fire engine.
