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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 3 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for home-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

<p><b>Maths</b> <b>Oak Academy</b> – this week we’ll be continuing our unit on place value. Complete a lesson each day (lessons 6-10) by clicking <a href="#">here</a></p> <p>Lesson 6– finding all possible numbers that could have been rounded to a multiple of 10. Lesson 7 – rounding 2 and 3 digit numbers to the nearest 100. Lesson 8 – applying place value knowledge to problem solving Lesson 9 – finding solutions to a problem Lesson 10 -place value application lesson</p> <p><b>Mental fluency</b> Play the <a href="#">Toy Shop Game</a> to practise your money skills. Choose mixed coins and then the finding change section.</p>	<p><b>English</b> <b>Oak Academy</b> – this week we complete our unit on Portia spiders – non-chronological reports. Click <a href="#">here</a> and choose a new lesson each day (lessons 16-20) .</p> <p><b>Extra writing challenge:</b> Watch the video of the book <a href="#">The First Drawing</a>. Imagine that you were born before the invention of drawing, what would it be like to see pictures all around you but nobody else understands you? You could write a story where you are the first person that paints on the cave wall.</p> <p>Take a look around you: can you see pictures or art in the clouds, shadows or colours? Draw what you can see and then use your pictures to tell your own story.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Log onto <a href="#">Bug Club</a> to see what books your teacher has given you to read. Perhaps you could create a book review of the book you most enjoyed reading.</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b> Log into <b>Purple Mash</b> and you will find your spelling list has been set as a <b>2do</b>. There is also a spelling quiz for you to complete. This week’s spellings all have the -sion ending.</p>
<p><b>Irresistible Learning:</b> <b>History/Art</b> - Dig It topic</p> <p>This week we will be learning about cave paintings. <a href="#">Watch</a> this short video and find out some information about cave paintings. Head over to <b>Purple Mash</b> where you will find a cave paintings <b>2do</b> to complete.</p> <p><b>Science</b> – Plants</p> <p>Take some time to look outside and find some signs of Spring. Can you see any plants that are starting to grow? Can you see any other changes that are taking place? You could draw a spring picture of what you can see. Think about how we feel when the seasons change: what are you looking forward to as we move from Winter into Spring? You could write down these feelings and add them onto your picture.</p>	<p><b>Wellbeing –being mindful</b></p> <p>In our increasingly busy world, it is so important to take a moment to be quiet and mindful. It can be tricky to slow your brain down when there are so many distractions around you. Focusing on a colouring activity can be really calming.</p> <p>Why not make your own mindful minute bookmark using ideas <a href="#">here</a>. Focusing on your senses can help to restore a feeling of calm when you are anxious or worried.</p>
