Autumn 2023, our first half term in...

Nursery

Our Nursery children have been learning all about autumn and exploring nature. We have been on an autumn walk and completed leaf rubbings. We have been mixing red and yellow colours to make orange and we have made lots of patterns with all the natural things we collected on our autumn walks.

Reception

The Reception classes have settled wonderfully into school routines and have made a fantastic start to their school journey. They have been singing songs to learn how to hold a pencil correctly and have begun to learn the sounds that letters make. The children are enjoying our different school areas and have particularly loved collecting natural objects on our autumn walks around our school grounds.

Year 1

Year 1 have been very busy learning all about bones! They have been finding out about bones in the human body and creating fabulous skeleton pictures. The children have also been carefully observing the signs of autumn around the school grounds, looking out for changes in our environment. The children are also studying our local area in Geography and have looked at the human geography of roads, shops, schools and landmarks eg the clock in Stourbridge town centre.

Year 2

All of the children in Year 2 have had a fantastic start to the term, learning about the Great Fire of London and even making their own bread. They have also been busy writing bread-making instructions for Mrs Hannaway to make her own! The children have loved the new Yoga unit in P.E., working on their strength and flexibility, and taking their mindfulness practice into other areas. 'I felt closer to nature when I was practising mindful breathing outside on the playground' Joel Y2.

Year 3

This half term, Y3 have loved doing Bikeability sessions with the Road Safety Team. Scarlett Y3- 'I learnt to ride my bike without stabilisers and I rode safely' and Benjamin Y3 'I loved Bikeability because I learnt new skills.' Dougie: 'I loved riding my bike and learnt some things I didn't know for my own safety, like what the chain looks like. It was lots of fun as I usually just ride my bike around the park.' Congratulations to everyone who took part in the course and well done to those children who were awarded their Bikeability Level 1 badge.

Year 4

Year 4 have been enjoying learning about the Anglo Saxons in their History work, and learnt about the Viking legend Beowulf. The children are really enthusiastic about our recorder lessons and they are gaining confidence in playing an instrument and learning about musical notation too. On Monday, the children visited Ridgewood High School to see a production of Matilda and everyone found the show really entertaining. It was great to see so many ex-Gig Mill students taking part too!

Year 5

Well done to all the children who took part in the Bikeability sessions and congratulations to everyone who achieved their Bikeability Level 2 badge. The children really enjoyed riding their bikes on the local roads and were really confident using their new skills to lead their instructors around a route. In History work, the children have been learning all about World War II and had a visit to RAF Cosford where they saw some original WWII aircraft and even experienced an air raid siren.
