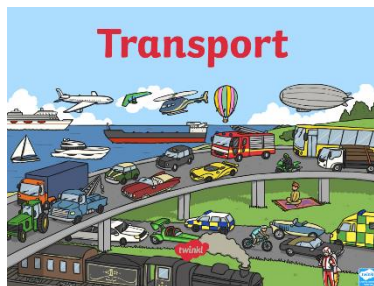


**Topic – Moving Along**

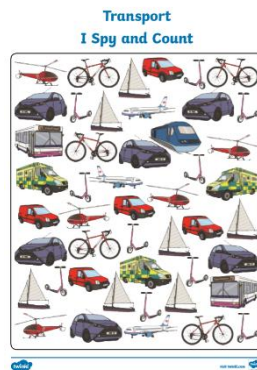
**Activities**

We would like you to:

- Look for different kinds of transport when you do your daily exercise
- Fine Motor Skills: play dough [make cars, lorries out of playdough], cutting around simple shapes like circles for wheels, jigsaws.

**Maths**

Use twinkl to access 'Transport I spy and count'



**Challenge**

Count how many lorries, vans or buses you see on your daily walk- Which did you see more of? How many did you see altogether?

**English**

- Practising pencil control by drawing roads with pencils or felts or chalks on the ground for cars, lorries etc to go on.

- Talking about experiences of going out for the day and/or holidays. Ask questions such as:

Where did you go?

What did you see?

Where is your favourite place to go?

- Phonics: Find a bag and put objects in, that begin with the same initial sound. Get your child to pull out an object one at a time and emphasise the initial sound. E.g. ssssssss for snake, ssssssss for sock etc so children get used to hearing initial sounds in words. Can they think of other words that begin with that sound?
- Writing: Practise writing their name in lower case letters.
