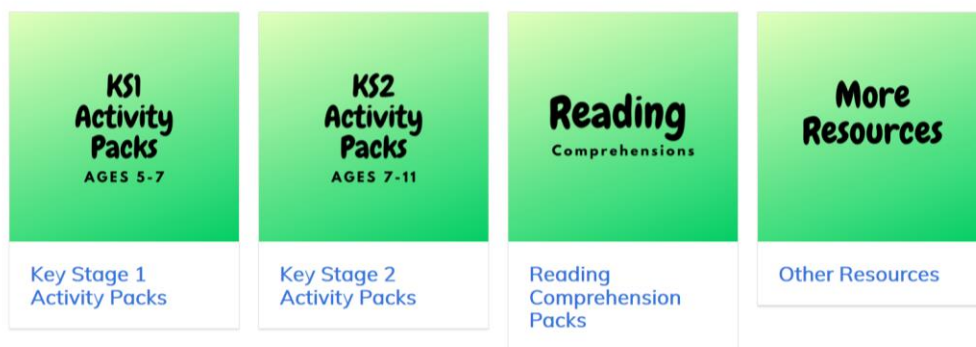


Notes for parents

The Literacy Shed website (<https://www.literacyshedplus.com/en-gb/browse/free-resources>) are offering some fantastic resources linked to videos/texts that you may want to do at home. Following the link provided will take you to this webpage and you can select which activity you would like to complete.



The KS1/KS2 activity packs offer age-appropriate short video-clips for the children to watch linked to an activity pack. These packs do not need to be printed - the children can complete any of the activities chosen on a suitable medium e.g. a word document on the computer or paper available at home. Some of the activities offer cross curricular learning opportunities and include creative/craft tasks and maths ones.

Any of the activities that require answers can be found on the final page of each activity pack.

PLEASE NOTE - The Literacy Shed website should ALWAYS be used under the supervision of an adult. There are some clips on the site which are only suitable for use with Year 6 children or KS3. Please ensure that children do not search the website independently.

The reading comprehension packs offer reading activities for all age groups - select the age group of your child/children and the pack will offer 5-6 suitable texts across a range of themes and genres.

The texts are exciting and fun to read - they can be used for daily reading sessions and creative writing. The questions are linked to key reading skills that would be covered in school and all answers are available after each question page.

The More resources section offer a 40 book-based activity list and a book scavenger hunt.
