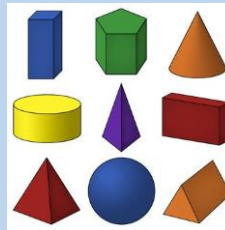


Year Group: Year 1	WEEK BEGINNING: 06.12.21

Maths – 3D Shape

This week we are continuing our work on place value. Look below for the lessons for this week. **Complete one lesson per day.**

Maths Fluency:

Practise your counting in 1's, 2's to 20 both forwards and backwards. Time yourself doing it and then challenge yourself to beat your time.

Irresistible Learning – Christmas

This week we are starting to think about Christmas. What things do you do to prepare for Christmas?

This week in topic we are going to write a letter to Father Christmas. Have a go at writing a letter to Father Christmas, you can tell him all the good things you have been doing at school, give him an idea of what you would like for Christmas and ask him about his reindeer. Father Christmas would love to see your lovely handwriting and capital letters and full stops. Once you've written your letter, have a go at drawing him a picture on the bottom of your letter.



English – Winter

Watch this [video](#) and look closely for the changes that you might see during Winter.

Lesson 1 - Create a winter mind map - draw a picture of winter in the middle of your page, around your picture write all the things you know about winter.

Lesson 2 - Make a list of all the items you may need to wear in winter e.g. hat, gloves etc.

Lesson 3 - Using your words from yesterday can you put them into sentences e.g. *In the winter you need to wear a hat and gloves.*

Lesson 4 - Can you write a weather report for winter? E.g. *Today is cold and windy This morning it was frosty. There is snow coming this evening.*

Lesson 5 - Can you perform your weather performance to your grown-ups? You might want to use props to help you.



Phonics:

Reading:
