Number, shape & measures:

Number of the Week: 6
 Can you show your adult 6 fingers? Can you find 6 of different objects in your house? You could find 6 pencils, 6 toys, 6 cushions, 6 books etc. Can you write the number 6?

Shape of the Week: Pentagon  How many sides does it have?

Counting: Can you build a tower of 6 bricks/cardboard boxes/lego bricks Now try making a tower of 10.

Communication, language & literacy

Word of the Week: Build

Reading We are sharing the story of **The Three Little Pigs** this week. Listen to the story [The Three Little Pigs](#) What did the three little pigs build their houses out of? Which one worked best? What happened to the houses? See if you can join in with the parts that are repeated "Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down!"


Phonics: This week we are learning the sound 'c and k' Listen to this song Jolly phonic song ck see if you can do the actions and say the sound. These two letters make the same sound but look different. Can you think of anything that begins with 'c'? [cat, cup, cot] and 'k' [kite, key, kangaroo] Have a look for some objects around your house that begin with 'c' and 'k'. Your adult can tell you which c/k sound it is. Writing/Mark Making: Have a go at drawing the 3 different houses from the story, or get your adult to draw them and you could add some straw, wood and bricks on.
