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

Number, shape & measures:


Number of the week: Our [number of the week](#) this week is 5. Which Numberblocks in the video joined together to make 5?



Shape of the week: cuboid. A cuboid is a 3D shape with rectangular faces. Can you find any cuboids at home?



Activity: Ask the children to investigate which shapes they can make by combining squares, rectangles and triangles in different ways. Can they build a small square, a medium square and a large square? What shapes did they use? Can they build it in a different way?

Lesson 3: Play [Picnic on Pluto](#). Select Phase 2 and revise all phase 2 to play the game.


Reading: Choose your favourite [nursery rhyme](#). Can you join in with the words? Draw a picture to show the nursery rhyme you have been singing.
