This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Nursery for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week. Please send us any photos of the activities you do through "Evidence Me".

<p><b>Number, shape &amp; measures:</b> <u>Shape:</u> Cut up some coloured pieces of paper, into rectangles, squares, circles, and triangles. Can you make a firework/rocket picture? If you have some black paper stick your firework down and make a starry sky background. <u>Counting:</u> Practise counting to 10 or 20 if ready. See if you can count backwards as well from 10. How old are you? What number comes next? What number comes before?</p> 	<p><b>Communication, language &amp; literacy</b> <u>Word of the Week:</u> Firework <u>Reading:</u> This week we are sharing the book <b>Dipal's Diwali</b>. You can share this book together <a href="#">Dipal's Diwali</a>. What have you learnt about Diwali? <u>Phonics: General Sound Discrimination- Instrumental sounds-</u> Watch this video and see if you can say which instrument the lady is playing each time <a href="#">Guess the Instrument</a> <u>Writing/Mark Making:</u> Can you have a go at designing your own Mehndi hand print? Look at the picture for ideas. (you might want to zoom in) Draw round your own hand first and then mark make some patterns for your design.</p> 
<p><b>Irresistible Learning Topic: <a href="#">Here I am: Celebrations- Bonfire Night and Diwali</a></b> <u>Bonfire Night</u> - Find out why we celebrate <b>Bonfire Night</b>. On <a href="#">Espresso</a> * search '<b>Bonfire Night</b>' and watch the video about it. What did you learn? What noises do fireworks make? <u>Diwali:</u> This week it is also Diwali, which is also known as the festival of light. It starts on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> November and is celebrated for 5 days by Hindus and Sikhs, as well as other religions. Watch this video to find out more about <a href="#">Diwali</a>. Tell your adult what you have learnt about the festival. <u>Media &amp; materials:</u> Fireworks are used to celebrate Bonfire Night and Diwali. Can you use some empty toilet rolls to make this firework picture? If you haven't got any paint at home, see if you can create a firework picture using crayons/felt tips/collage etc.</p> 	<p><b>Wellbeing- 5 steps to wellbeing-</b> This week we are thinking about our families and how we can show them that we care. This could be through the words we say, small gifts we might buy or through acts of kindness. Think of something that you could do to show someone in your family that you care. You could help them to complete a household task and you can tell them how much they mean to you!</p>
